- Perform numerical modeling of nearshore coastal processes including tidal hydrodynamics, water quality, waves, and sediment transport;
- Prepare impact assessments and federal, state, and local permit applications;
- Prepare correspondence and reports that are clear, concise, and technically sound;
- Demonstrate consistent attention to detail and ability to manage time to meet specified budgets and schedules;
- Contribute to business development and preparation of proposals; and
- Apply strong project and client management skills to varied assignments.
